




I wish all children have the freedom to live so they may never know the underpinnings of our efforts; that they can have full sovereignty and become self-actualized humans capable of dreaming and reaching their full potential.

You have joined forces to ensure children's dreams are met with compassion, loyalty, and support. You are the voice for the voiceless, and your role is vital to our success. We can't all do everything; however, we can all do something. And that's why you're here; you care deeply about the welfare of children, and for that, I wholeheartedly thank YOU.

This year, we've made a lot of progress in our efforts. In Nepal, the INpowerment Center is fully operational, and students can attend

school full-time while receiving leadership and self-development training. When parents were asked what they were most excited about having their daughters attend the center, one father replied, "she is finally able to have pens and paper." Two other parents responded that their daughters "no longer have to trek 3 hours to school, each way, on steep terrain." Wow, can you imagine if our life's simplest resources were no longer available?

Our Compass Rose Curriculum is continually being developed and improved. We are supporting Denver children, too, through 6-week inschool accelerators (Denver Montessori Junior/Senior High School) and are culturally adapting the transformative process for the Nepal INpowerment Center later this year.

APPROACH METHODOLOGY



LEADERSHIP TRAINING

When a young woman can see her potential, and in turn, continue that ripple through her own community, is when trafficking stops.



RESCUE

We partner with international rescue organizations to provide valuable data that assists in the rescue of children from the villages in which we operate.



SOCIAL ENTERPRISE

Our co-facilitated training program helps women to apply for loans to start businesses. The program includes training and technical assistance in business plan development, management, bookkeeping, marketing, and farm-to-market facilitation.

Ending trafficking is a multi-faceted approach in which the entire community needs to take ownership. Helping just the children isn't a solution, but ensuring that families and members within the community have access to resources and job creation is equally as important.



EDUCATION

Educated children and their families are much more aware, alert, and mature, and they can comprehend the risks of child trafficking quite well.



SELF DEFENSE

Tackling the child trafficking epidemic wouldn't be complete without providing the skills and training to defend oneself should the situation arise.



JOB CREATION

For all of our work, we employ locals. Additionally, we reduce transportation costs by introducing brick-making to the community. This has created sustainable jobs.

NEPAL PROGRAMS

MICROFINANCE PROGRAM

We are working with the local women's group, RedPanda, to support 20 families with the social entrepreneurial business within the community. We have donated an innovative brick-making machine, provided training, and empowered entrepreneurs to produce high-quality bricks, using local materials ideally suited to rural communities. To date, we have employed 100 community members through our brick-making program

LEADERSHIP WORKSHOPS

Nepal charities and local schools have worked with us to develop a leadership curriculum and provide training for young women within the community.

Our volunteers work with us to provide free self-defense classes in Brazilian JiuJitsu in local schools. Currently, we have trained over 100 girls and women.



INpowerment Center for Girls

Our dormitory and learning center is located in the remote access Nepali Himalayas. Our center provides equal access to education and accommodation for girls who live over a 1-hour trek from school and are at-risk for child sex trafficking and orphan trafficking. It has 38 full time residents that includes 32 students, 2 security guards, 1 house mother, 1 cook lead, 1 cook helper, and 1 operations manager. This project also supports the Nepal Government National Plan to eliminate child trafficking, outlined by the United Nations International Organization for Migration (IOM).

Programming includes

anti-trafficking awareness, leadership, socioemotional wellness, and self-development.




